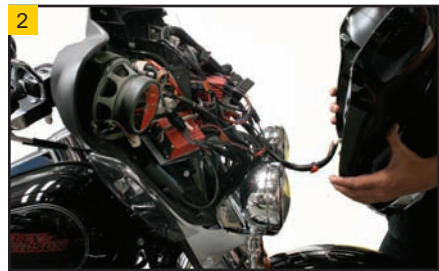
AM/FM Electronic Antenna

It is always nice to have tunes while cruising on your Bagger, but some of the antenna designs out there leave a lot to be desired. A two foot whip antenna sticking off the back of the Bagger is not only ugly, but it can also be downright dangerous. That's where Dakota Digital comes in with their AM/FM Electronic Antenna. It is a very small high performance antenna that can be mounted just about anywhere to give excellent reception without getting in the way. The best part is that the antenna is easy to install. Watch and see as we install one inside the fairing of a Bagger.



1 Remove the screws holding the outer fairing in place.



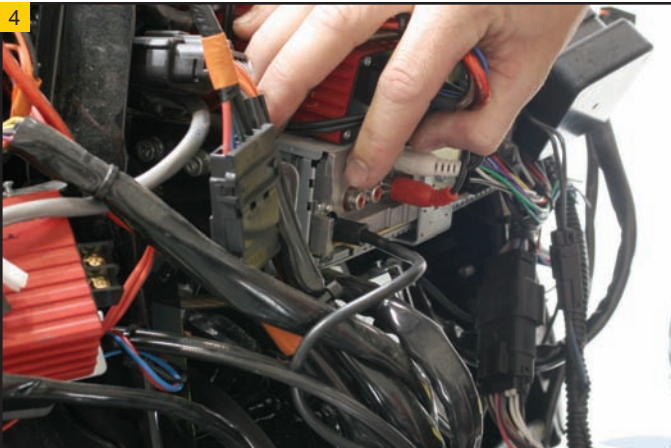
2 Next, remove the outer fairing.



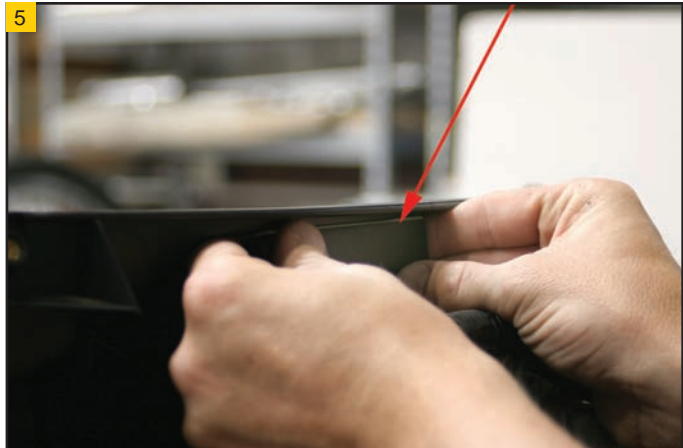
3 Disconnect the headlight, and set the outer fairing aside.



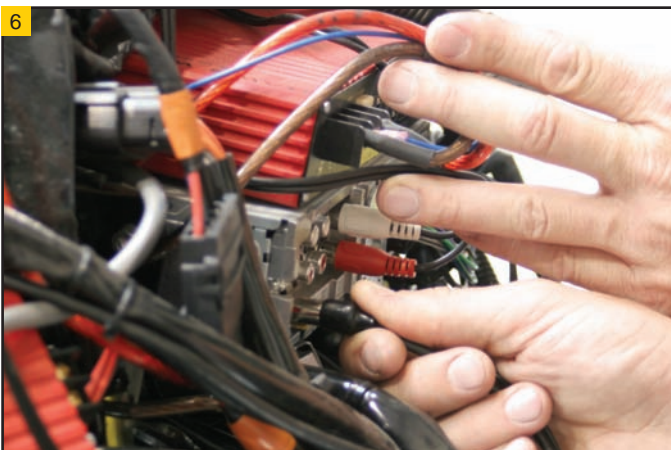
AM/FM Electronic Antenna



Now, unplug the existing antenna and remove it.



Find a good location for the antenna, peel the backing off the two-sided tape, and press it in place.



Plug the antenna lead into the antenna jack on the head unit.



Plug the headlight back into the wiring harness, and reassemble the fairing.



Finally, put the screws back in the outer fairing, and then crank up that radio and go cruising.
